About CCNA

The CCNA certification (Cisco Certified Network Associate) is Cisco's foundation-level networking certification. Upon completion, CCNA candidates should be able to successfully carry out any number of essential networking maintenance and troubleshooting duties such as installing, configuring and operating LAN, WAN and dial access services for small networks, as well as having good working knowledge of protocols such as IP, IGRP, Serial, Frame Relay, IP RIP, VLAN's, Ethernet and Access Lists.

There are two options to attaining your CCNA

Courses: Two courses are recommended for CCNA 640-802 certification:

- Interconnecting Cisco Network Devices, Part 1 (ICND1)
- Interconnecting Cisco Network Devices, Part 2 (ICND2)

Exams: CCNA 640-802 composite exam or 640-822 ICND1 (CCENT) and 640-816 ICND2
